- 1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, further providing for the grading of
- 3 theft offenses.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 3903(a.1) of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 8 § 3903. Grading of theft offenses.
- 9 * * *
- 10 (a.1) Felony of the third degree.--Except as provided in
- 11 subsection (a), theft constitutes a felony of the third degree
- 12 if the amount involved exceeds \$2,000, OR IF THE OFFENSE IS A
- 13 THIRD OR SUBSECUENT OFFENSE REGARDLESS OF THE AMOUNT INVOLVED,
- 14 or if the property stolen is an automobile, airplane,
- 15 motorcycle, motorboat or other motor-propelled vehicle, or in
- 16 the case of theft by receiving stolen property, if the receiver
- 17 is in the business of buying or selling stolen property. _ or if <—

- 1 the offense is a third or subsequent offense regardless of the
- 2 <u>amount involved</u>.

- 4 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
