5	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6	hereby enacts as follows:
7	Section 1. Section 3112 of Title 42 of the Pennsylvania
8	Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
9	§ 3112. Course of instruction and examination required.
10	District justices, bail commissioners and judges who are not
11	members of the bar of this Commonwealth shall complete a course
12	of training and instruction in the duties of their respective
13	offices and pass an examination prior to assuming office[.] <u>no</u>
14	later than when they are elected at the November election. In
15	the case of those appointed to fill a vacancy, only those who
16	are members of the bar of this Commonwealth or have completed
17	the course of training and instruction and passed the
18	examination shall be eligible for appointment.

1 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
