7	hereby enacts as follows:
8	Section 1. Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
9	Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
10	§ 4915. False or fraudulent statements involving child day-care
11	centers or family child day-care homes.
12	(a) Offense defined A person commits a felony of the third
13	degree if he knowingly does any of the following:
14	(1) Fails, by false statement, misrepresentation,
15	impersonation or other fraudulent means, to disclose in any
16	application for voluntary or paid employment or licensure or
17	registration all information required under Article X of the
18	act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), known as the Public

- 2 (relating to information relating to prospective child-care
- 3 personnel) and related regulations or a material fact used in
- 4 <u>making a determination as to such person's qualifications to</u>
- 5 <u>be a facility person, owner or operator of a child day-care</u>
- 6 <u>center or a family child day-care home.</u>
- 7 (2) Operates, maintains, conducts or attempts to operate
- 8 <u>a child day-care center without having a license issued by</u>
- 9 the department.
- 10 (3) Operates, maintains, conducts or attempts to operate
- a family child day-care home without registering with the
- department.
- 13 (4) Operates, maintains, conducts or attempts to operate
- 14 a child day-care center or a family child day-care home under
- 15 <u>a license or registration that is suspended, revoked or</u>
- 16 terminated.
- 17 (5) Misrepresents, by act or omission, to a parent or
- 18 quardian who has a child placed in the facility or is
- 19 inquiring as to placing a child in the facility, or to a
- 20 representative of the department, or to a representative of a
- 21 <u>law enforcement agency, that a child day-care center or</u>
- family child day-care home is duly licensed or registered
- 23 pursuant to the laws of this Commonwealth without being so
- 24 <u>licensed or registered.</u>
- 25 (6) Makes any other misrepresentation, by act or
- 26 <u>omission, regarding the licensure or operation of a child</u>
- 27 <u>day-care center or family child day-care home to a parent or</u>
- 28 <u>quardian who has a child placed in the facility or is</u>
- 29 inquiring as to placing a child in the facility, or to a
- 30 representative of the department, or to a representative of a

- 2 misrepresentation as to:
- 3 <u>(i) The number of children at the child day-care</u>
- 4 <u>center or the family day-care home.</u>
- 5 (ii) The part of the child day-care center or family
- 6 <u>child day-care home designated for child care.</u>
- 7 (iii) The qualifications or credentials or training
- 8 <u>of a facility person, owner or operator.</u>
- 9 <u>(b) Parent or guardian reliance on misrepresentation.--If</u>
- 10 any facility person, owner or operator of a child day-care
- 11 <u>center or family day-care home makes any misrepresentation in</u>
- 12 <u>violation of this section to a parent or quardian who has placed</u>
- 13 <u>a child in the child day-care center or family day-care home</u>,
- 14 and the parent or quardian relied upon the misrepresentation,
- 15 and the child suffers great bodily harm, permanent
- 16 <u>disfigurement</u>, <u>permanent disability or death as a result of an</u>
- 17 <u>intentional act or negligence by the facility person, owner or</u>
- 18 operator, then the facility person, owner or operator commits a
- 19 felony of the second degree.
- 20 (c) Definitions. -- As used in this section, the following
- 21 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
- 22 subsection:
- 23 "Child day care." Care in lieu of parental care given for
- 24 part of the 24-hour day to children away from their own home.
- 25 <u>"Child day-care center." The premises in which child day</u>
- 26 care is provided at any one time for seven or more children
- 27 unrelated to the operator.
- 28 "Department." The Department of Public Welfare of the
- 29 <u>Commonwealth.</u>
- 30 <u>"Facility person." A group supervisor, assistant group</u>

- 1 supervisor, aide, volunteer, food service person, janitorial
- 2 person or another adult who serves in or is employed by a child
- 3 <u>day-care center or a family day-care home.</u>
- 4 <u>"Family child day-care home" or "family day-care home." A</u>
- 5 home other than the child's own home, operated for profit or
- 6 not-for-profit, in which child day care is provided at any time
- 7 to four through six children unrelated to the operator.
- 8 <u>"Owner." The legal entity or individual who owns the child</u>
- 9 day-care center or family day-care home.
- 10 "Operator." The legal entity or a person designated by the
- 11 <u>legal entity to serve as the child day-care center director or</u>
- 12 <u>family day-care home administrator</u>.
- 13 <u>"Person." An individual, partnership, association or</u>
- 14 corporation.
- 15 Section 2. Sections 1031 and 1078 of the act of June 13,
- 16 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), known as the Public Welfare Code, are
- 17 repealed.
- 18 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
