## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 30 (Fish) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 2 Statutes, further providing for the term of office for
- 3 commissioners and for removal from office.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 301(c) and (d) of Title 30 of the
- 7 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended to read:
- 8 § 301. Organization of commission.
- 9 \* \* \*
- 10 (c) Terms of office and compensation. -- The members shall
- 11 hold office for terms of [eight] five years and may continue to
- 12 hold office for a period of time not to exceed six months or
- 13 until a successor is appointed and qualified, whichever occurs
- 14 first. [A member appointed to fill a vacancy for a period of
- 15 four years or less may be eligible for appointment to a full
- 16 eight-year term. A member who serves a full eight-year term or
- 17 fills a vacancy for a period of more than four years shall not

- 1 be eligible for reappointment to the commission until a period
- 2 of eight years expires.] A member of the commission is eliqible
- 3 for and may be appointed for a second and subsequent term of
- 4 five years. The members shall receive no compensation for their
- 5 services but may be reimbursed for travel expenses. When
- 6 performing any function on behalf of the commission or acting
- 7 within the scope of their official duties, members of the
- 8 commission shall be authorized to operate Commonwealth vehicles
- 9 and watercraft and shall be treated as employees of the
- 10 Commonwealth for the purposes of automotive and general
- 11 liability and the act of June 2, 1915 (P.L.736, No.338), known
- 12 as the Workers' Compensation Act.
- 13 (d) Vacancies.--Upon the death, resignation or removal <u>for</u>
- 14 cause after notice and hearing from office of any member, the
- 15 Governor shall appoint a competent person to serve for the
- 16 unexpired term.

- 18 Section 2. The provisions of 30 Pa.C.S. § 301(c) shall not
- 19 be construed to reduce the term of office for the members of the
- 20 commission holding office on the effective date of this act.
- 21 Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2001.
