AN ACT

1 Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An  
2 act relating to the public school system, including certain  
3 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial  
4 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the  
5 laws relating thereto," providing for supplemental payments  
6 on account of transportation for severe special education  
7 students.

8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
9 hereby enacts as follows:

10 Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known  
11 as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a  
12 section to read:

13 Section 2541.1. Supplemental Payments on Account of  
14 Transportation for Severe Special Education Students.--Beginning  
15 with the 2001-2002 school year, each school district providing  
16 transportation for its resident students shall receive a  
17 supplemental payment for the transportation of severe special

1 education students equal to the product of one per centum (1%)  
2 of the school district's average daily membership times one  
3 thousand eight hundred dollars (\$1,800).

4 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2001.
