- 1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated 2 Statutes, further providing for the violation of safety
- 3 requirements for towed vehicles.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 4905(f) of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 8 § 4905. Safety requirements for towed vehicles.

- 10 (f) Penalty for violation of [subsection (e)] <u>subsections</u>
- 11 <u>(d) and (e)</u>.--
- 12 (1) A person who operates a commercial motor vehicle, as
- defined in section 1603 (relating to definitions), in
- 14 violation of subsection (d) or (e) commits a summary offense
- and shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of
- 16 \$300 for each violation.
- 17 (2) A person who operates a motor vehicle other than a

- commercial motor vehicle, as defined in section 1603, in 1
- violation of subsection (d) or (e) commits a summary offense 2
- and shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of not 3
- 4 less than \$50 nor more than \$100.
- 5 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 90 days.
