1 2 3	Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for footrests and handlebars on motorcycles.
4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby enacts as follows:
6	Section 1. Section 3524 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
7	Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
8	§ 3524. Footrests and [handlebars] <u>handhold</u> .
9	[(a) Passengers]Any motorcycle carrying a passenger,
LO	other than in a sidecar or enclosed cab, shall be equipped with
1	footrests and handhold for the passenger.
L2	[(b) Height of handlebarsNo person shall operate any
13	motorcycle with handlebars above shoulder-height of the operator
L4	while properly seated upon the motorcycle.]

1 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
