## AN ACT

- Amending the act of March 4, 1971 (P.L.6, No.2), entitled "An act relating to tax reform and State taxation by codifying 3 and enumerating certain subjects of taxation and imposing taxes thereon; providing procedures for the payment, 5 collection, administration and enforcement thereof; providing for tax credits in certain cases; conferring powers and 7 imposing duties upon the Department of Revenue, certain employers, fiduciaries, individuals, persons, corporations 8 9 and other entities; prescribing crimes, offenses and penalties," further providing for sales and use tax 10 exclusions. 11
- 12 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 13 hereby enacts as follows:
- 14 Section 1. Section 204 of the act of March 4, 1971 (P.L.6,
- 15 No.2), known as the Tax Reform Code of 1971, is amended by

- 17 Section 204. Exclusions from Tax.--The tax imposed by

- dogs and the sale at retail or use of feed, grooming supplies, 4
- veterinarian services and portable cages for guide, signal or 5

- impaired, deaf, auditorially impaired or physically limited. 8
- 9 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
