- 1 Amending Title 24 (Education) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated 2 Statutes, further providing for creditable nonschool service
- and for contributions for purchase of credit for creditable
- 4 nonschool service.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Section 8304(a) of Title 24 of the Pennsylvania
- 8 Consolidated Statutes, amended May 17, 2001 (P.L.26, No.9), is
- 9 amended to read:
- 10 § 8304. Creditable nonschool service.
- 11 (a) Eligibility.--An active member or a multiple service
- 12 member who is an active member of the State Employees'
- 13 Retirement System shall be eligible to receive Class T-C service
- 14 credit for creditable nonschool service and Class T-D service
- 15 for intervening military service and for creditable maternity
- 16 <u>leave</u>, provided the member elects to become a Class T-D member
- 17 pursuant to section 8305.1 (relating to election to become a

- 1 Class T-D member), as set forth in subsection (b) provided that
- 2 he is not entitled to receive, eligible to receive now or in the
- 3 future, or is receiving retirement benefits for such service
- 4 under a retirement system administered and wholly or partially
- 5 paid for by any other governmental agency or by any private
- 6 employer, or a retirement program approved by the employer in
- 7 accordance with section 8301(a)(1) (relating to mandatory and
- 8 optional membership), and further provided that such service is
- 9 certified by the previous employer and the manner of payment of
- 10 the amount due is agreed upon by the member, the employer, and
- 11 the board.

- 13 Section 2. Section 8324(f) of Title 24 is amended to read:
- 14 § 8324. Contributions for purchase of credit for creditable
- 15 nonschool service.
- 16 * * *
- 17 (f) Creditable maternity leave. -- Contributions on account of
- 18 Class T-C credit or Class T-D credit if the member is a Class T-
- 19 <u>D member</u> for creditable maternity leave pursuant to section
- 20 8304(b)(7) shall be determined by applying the member's basic
- 21 contribution rate plus the normal contribution rate as provided
- 22 in section 8328 at the time of the member's return to school
- 23 service to the total compensation received during the first year
- 24 of subsequent school service and multiplying the product by the
- 25 number of years and fractional part of a year of creditable
- 26 service being purchased, together with statutory interest during
- 27 all periods of subsequent school or State service to the date of
- 28 purchase. The amount paid for the purchase of credit for
- 29 creditable maternity leave shall not be eligible for withdrawal
- 30 as a lump sum under section 8345(a)(4)(iii).

- 2 Section 3. The amendment of 24 Pa.C.S. §§ 8304(a) and
- 3 8324(f) shall be retroactive to July 1, 2001.
- 4 Section 4. This act shall take effect immediately.
