## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 2 Statutes, further providing for additional parking
- 3 regulations.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 3354(d) of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended and the section is amended by
- 8 adding a subsection to read:
- 9 § 3354. Additional parking regulations.
- 10 \* \* \*
- 11 (d) Handicapped persons and disabled veterans.--
- 12 (1) When a motor vehicle bearing a handicapped or
- 13 severely disabled veteran plate or displaying a handicapped
- or severely disabled veteran parking placard as prescribed in
- 15 this title is being operated by or for the transportation of
- 16 the handicapped person or severely disabled veteran, the

- driver shall be relieved of any liability for parking for a period of 60 minutes in excess of the legal parking period permitted by local authorities except where local ordinances or police regulations provide for the accommodation of heavy traffic during morning, afternoon or evening hours.
  - (2) At the request of any handicapped person or severely disabled veteran, local authorities may erect on the highway as close as possible to their place of residence a sign or signs indicating that that place is reserved for the handicapped person or severely disabled veteran, that no parking is allowed there by others, and that any unauthorized person parking there shall be subject to a fine.
- (i) Except for persons parking vehicles lawfully bearing a handicapped or severely disabled veteran registration plate or displaying a handicapped or severely disabled veteran parking placard when such vehicles are being operated by or for the transportation of a handicapped person or a severely disabled veteran, no person shall park a vehicle on public or private property reserved for a handicapped person or severely disabled veteran which property has been so posted in accordance with departmental regulations which shall require a sign stating the penalty amount indicated in subsection (f), a sign indicating that vehicles in violation of the subsection may be towed and require that signs be replaced when they become either obsolete or missing with all costs to replace the necessary signs to be borne by the persons responsible for signing the particular location. Any vehicle which is unlawfully parked in a designated handicapped parking area may be

removed from that area by towing and may be reclaimed by the vehicle owner upon payment of the towing costs. The failure of a person responsible for signing a particular location to post property reserved for handicapped person or severely disabled veteran parking with a penalties sign, a sign indicating that the vehicle in violation may be towed or any other sign which may be required by departmental regulation is no defense to prosecution for a violation of this subsection.

(ii) Local authorities shall have the power and may, by ordinance or resolution, authorize handicapped persons and severely disabled veterans to issue statements to violators or violating vehicles for violation of subparagraph (i). The form of the statement shall be as prescribed by the local authorities.

(iii) Within 90 days of the effective date of this subparagraph, the department shall adopt and promulgate regulations to govern the description, placement, size and installation of the penalties sign under this subsection. The penalties sign shall indicate the minimum and maximum fine for violations and that the violating vehicle may be towed.

25 It is the intent of the General Assembly that parking spaces
