- 1 Amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the
- 2 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for
- 3 death action.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 8301(b) of Title 42 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 8 § 8301. Death action.
- 9 * * *
- 10 (b) Beneficiaries.--Except as provided in subsection (d),
- 11 the right of action created by this section shall exist only for
- 12 the benefit of the spouse, children or parents of the deceased,
- 13 whether or not citizens or residents of this Commonwealth or
- 14 elsewhere. The damages recovered shall be distributed to the
- 15 beneficiaries in the proportion they would take the personal
- 16 estate of the decedent in the case of intestacy and without
- 17 liability to creditors of the deceased person under the statutes

- 1 of this Commonwealth. For the purposes of this section only,
- 2 <u>children shall include stepchildren who were dependent upon the</u>
- 3 <u>decedent at the time of death for support and they shall</u>
- 4 participate in the damages as though they were issue of the
- 5 <u>decedent</u>.

- 7 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
