- 26 FEES RELATING TO MOTORCYCLE LICENSES FOR MOTORCYCLE OPERATORS

- 28 ADDITION TO ANY OTHER FEES IMPOSED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THIS

- 6 COLLECTED FOR EACH MOTORCYCLE LEARNER'S PERMIT.
- 7 (4) AN ADDITIONAL FEE OF [\$2] \$5 SHALL BE ASSESSED AND
- COLLECTED FOR EACH REPLACEMENT MOTORCYCLE OPERATOR'S LICENSE. 8
- 9 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
