- 14 (b) Marriage and family therapists. -- The requirements of

- 4 (iii) Has a master's degree of less than 48 semester 5 hours or 72 quarter hours [but not less than 36 semester hours or 54 quarter hours] in marriage and family therapy 6 or in a field determined by the board by regulation to be 7 closely related to the practice of marriage and family 8 therapy from an accredited educational institution with 9 10 graduate level coursework in marriage and family therapy 11 acceptable to the board and has within the past ten years completed sufficient continuing education satisfactory to 12 13 the board to equal the number of hours needed to achieve 14 a total of 48 semester hours or 72 quarter hours at a 15 ratio of 15 continuing education hours equaling one 16 semester hour.

- 18 (c) Professional counselors.—The requirements of section 19 7(f)(4) shall not apply and a license shall be issued without 20 examination to an applicant who meets all of the following

- (iii) Has a master's degree of less than 48 semester
 hours or 72 quarter hours [but not less than 36 semester
 hours or 54 quarter hours] in professional counseling or
 a field determined by the board by regulation to be
 closely related to the practice of professional

counseling and has within the past ten years completed
sufficient continuing education satisfactory to the board
to equal the number of hours needed to achieve a total of
4 semester hours or 72 quarter hours at a ratio of 15
continuing education hours equaling one semester hour.
