AN ACT

Amending the act of May 20, 1993 (P.L.38, No.11), entitled "An 2 act establishing the Agricultural Advisory Board in the Department of Environmental Resources and prescribing its 3 powers; and providing for review by the board of certain 4 proposed rules and regulations, "further providing for 6 establishment of board; and making editorial changes. 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: The title and section 1 of the act of May 20, 9 Section 1. 10 1993 (P.L.38, No.11), known as the Department of Environmental 11 Resources Agricultural Advisory Board Act, are amended to read: 12 AN ACT 13 Establishing the Agricultural Advisory Board in the Department 14 of Environmental [Resources] Protection and prescribing its powers; and providing for review by the board of certain 15

- 2 This act shall be known and may be cited as the Department of
- 3 Environmental [Resources] Protection Agricultural Advisory Board
- 4 Act.
- 5 Section 2. The definitions of "department" and "secretary"
- 6 in section 2 of the act are amended to read:
- 7 Section 2. Definitions.
- 8 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
- 9 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 10 context clearly indicates otherwise:

- 12 "Department." The Department of Environmental [Resources]
- 13 Protection of the Commonwealth.

- "Secretary." The Secretary of Environmental [Resources]

- 18 Section 3. Section 3 of the act is amended to read:
- 19 Section 3. Establishment of board.
- 20 (a) Creation. -- There is hereby established in the Department
- 21 of Environmental [Resources] Protection the Agricultural
- 22 Advisory Board.
- 23 (b) Members.--The following persons shall comprise the
- 24 board:
- 25 (1) Representatives of the Pennsylvania [Farmers
- Association] Farm Bureau, the Pennsylvania State Grange,
- 27 <u>PennAq Industries Association</u> and the Pennsylvania Farmers
- 28 Union. Each of these organizations shall annually name one
- 29 person to represent it under this paragraph.
- 30 (2) A dairy producer, a livestock producer, a poultry

- 1 producer, a grain producer, a fruit producer, a vegetable
- 2 producer, a representative of the ornamental horticultural
- 3 industry, a producer engaged in sustainable agriculture and a
- 4 representative from the agri-business industry. The Governor
- 5 shall appoint these representatives to sit for a three-year
- 6 term. Representatives appointed under this paragraph must
- 7 receive a majority of their gross income from the activity
- 8 which they represent.
- 9 (3) Representatives of the Pennsylvania Association of
- 10 Conservation District Directors and The Pennsylvania State
- 11 University. Each of these organizations shall annually name
- one person to represent it under this paragraph.
- 13 (4) Representatives of the Federal [Soil Conservation
- 14 Service] Farm Service Agency and the Federal [Agricultural
- 15 Stabilization and] <u>Natural Resources</u> Conservation Service.
- 16 Each of these organizations shall annually name one person to
- 17 represent it under this paragraph ex officio.
- 18 (5) Representatives of the Department of Agriculture and
- the Department of Environmental [Resources] Protection. Each
- 20 department shall annually name one person to represent it
- 21 under this paragraph ex officio.
- 22 (6) The chairman and the minority chairman of the
- 23 Agriculture and Rural Affairs Committee of the Senate or
- their designees and the chairman and the minority chairman of
- 25 the Agriculture and Rural Affairs Committee of the House of
- Representatives or their designees to represent the General
- 27 Assembly [ex officio].
- 28 (c) Chairman. -- The members designated under subsection
- 29 (b)(1) shall annually rotate as board chairman.
- 30 (d) Staff.--The Department of Environmental [Resources]

- 1 Protection shall furnish the board with administrative support.
- 2 Section 4. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
