12	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
13	hereby enacts as follows:
14	Section 1. The act of June 21, 1957 (P.L.390, No.212),
15	referred to as the Right-to-Know Law, is amended by adding a
16	section to read:
17	Section 2.1. A person doing or attempting to do business
18	with the Commonwealth shall have the right to examine and
19	inspect any file, document or other information maintained by
20	the Commonwealth which relates to the person's work or to
21	anything else which may have been used by the Commonwealth as

1	grounds to revoke a contract or to refuse to contract with the
2	person. The person shall also have the rights established under
3	section 3 of this act with respect to such files, documents and
4	other information.
5	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
