INTRODUCED BY FLEAGLE, APRIL 8, 2002

SENATOR THOMPSON, APPROPRIATIONS, IN SENATE, RE-REPORTED AS AMENDED, JUNE 27, 2002

AN ACT

1 Making appropriations to the Philadelphia Health and Education  
2 Corporation for the ~~MCP Hahnemann University~~ COLLEGES OF ←  
3 MEDICINE, PUBLIC HEALTH, NURSING AND HEALTH PROFESSIONS and  
4 for continuation of pediatric services.

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. (a) The sum of ~~\$7,735,000~~ \$8,142,000 is hereby ←  
8 appropriated to the Philadelphia Health and Education  
9 Corporation for the ~~MCP Hahnemann University~~ COLLEGE OF MEDICINE ←  
10 for the fiscal year July 1, 2002, to June 30, 2003, for  
11 instruction in the Doctor of Medicine program.

12 (b) The sum of \$1,708,000 is hereby appropriated to the  
13 Philadelphia Health and Education Corporation for the ~~MCP~~ ←  
14 ~~Hahnemann University~~ COLLEGES OF MEDICINE, PUBLIC HEALTH, ←  
15 NURSING AND HEALTH PROFESSIONS for the fiscal year July 1, 2002,  
16 to June 30, 2003, for the general maintenance of the ~~MCP~~ ←  
17 ~~Hahnemann University~~ COLLEGES OF MEDICINE, PUBLIC HEALTH AND ←

1 NURSING, including the Allied Health, Professions and Graduate <—  
2 ~~School of the MCP Hahnemann University, and student~~ GRADUATE <—  
3 SCHOOLS, AND FOR STUDENT aid.

4 (c) The sum of \$305,000 is hereby appropriated to the  
5 Philadelphia Health and Education Corporation for the MCP <—  
6 ~~Hahnemann University~~ for the fiscal year July 1, 2002, to June  
7 30, 2003, for minority educational and recruitment programs.

8 (d) The sum of \$751,000 is hereby appropriated to the  
9 Philadelphia Health and Education Corporation, for the fiscal  
10 year July 1, 2002, to June 30, 2003, for continued pediatric  
11 outpatient and inpatient treatment of severe physically  
12 disabling diseases.

13 (e) The sum of \$158,000 is hereby appropriated to the  
14 Philadelphia Health and Education Corporation, for the fiscal  
15 year July 1, 2002, to June 30, 2003, for continued support of  
16 the handicapped children's clinic.

17 (f) The sum of \$2,000,000 is hereby appropriated to the  
18 Philadelphia Health and Education Corporation, for the MCP <—  
19 ~~Hahnemann University~~ COLLEGE OF MEDICINE for the fiscal year <—  
20 July 1, 2002, to June 30, 2003, for operating expenses.

21 (G) THE SUM OF \$500,000 IS HEREBY APPROPRIATED TO THE <—  
22 PHILADELPHIA HEALTH AND EDUCATION CORPORATION, FOR THE FISCAL  
23 YEAR JULY 1, 2002, TO JUNE 30, 2003, FOR CARDIOVASCULAR STUDIES.

24 Section 2. (a) Payments to the Philadelphia Health and  
25 Education Corporation ~~for the MCP Hahnemann University~~ on <—  
26 account of the appropriations provided in section 1(a), (b), ~~(e)~~ <—  
27 ~~and (f)~~ (C), (F) AND (G) shall be made quarterly by the <—  
28 Secretary of Education on the basis of costs during the fiscal  
29 year and shall be conditioned on continuing authority for  
30 inclusion on the Board of Trustees of the Philadelphia Health

1 and Education Corporation of a minimum of five persons who are  
2 not elected officials and who are appointed by the Governor, the  
3 President pro tempore of the Senate, the Minority Leader of the  
4 Senate, the Speaker of the House of Representatives and the  
5 Minority Leader of the House of Representatives for terms of  
6 office coterminous with that of the respective appointing  
7 authority; and shall be further conditioned on these appointees  
8 receiving full voting rights as members of the board of  
9 trustees.

10 (b) Payments to the Philadelphia Health and Education  
11 Corporation on account of the appropriations provided in section  
12 1(d) and (e) shall be made by the Secretary of Health in equal  
13 quarterly payments.

14 Section 3. (a) The Philadelphia Health and Education  
15 Corporation ~~for the MCP Hahnemann University~~ shall provide full, <—  
16 complete and accurate information for the appropriations under  
17 section 1(a), (b), (c) ~~and (f)~~, (F) AND (G) as may be required <—  
18 by the Department of Education or the chairman or the minority  
19 chairman of the Appropriations Committee of the Senate or the  
20 chairman or the minority chairman of the Appropriations  
21 Committee of the House of Representatives.

22 (b) The Philadelphia Health and Education Corporation shall  
23 provide full, complete and accurate information for the  
24 appropriations under section 1(d) and (e) as may be required by  
25 the Department of Health or the chairman or the minority  
26 chairman of the Appropriations Committee of the Senate or the  
27 chairman or the minority chairman of the Appropriations  
28 Committee of the House of Representatives.

29 Section 4. The Philadelphia Health and Education Corporation  
30 for the ~~MCP Hahnemann University~~ COLLEGES OF MEDICINE, PUBLIC <—

1 HEALTH, NURSING AND HEALTH PROFESSIONS shall report its revenues  
2 and expenditures and present its financial statements in  
3 accordance with generally accepted accounting principles and  
4 procedures for educational institutions as set forth in the  
5 "Higher Education Finance Manual (1975)" and the "Commonwealth  
6 of Pennsylvania Budget Instructions for the State System of  
7 Higher Education, State-Related Universities and Non-State-  
8 Related Colleges and Universities."

9 Section 5. The trustees of the Philadelphia Health and  
10 Education Corporation for the ~~MCP Hahnemann University~~ COLLEGES ←  
11 OF MEDICINE, PUBLIC HEALTH, NURSING AND HEALTH PROFESSIONS shall  
12 report on forms provided by the Department of Education to both  
13 the chairman and minority chairman of the Appropriations  
14 Committee of the Senate and the chairman and minority chairman  
15 of the Appropriations Committee of the House of Representatives  
16 by September 30, 2003, on how State-appropriated funds were  
17 expended for fiscal year 2002-2003 to reduce the costs to  
18 Pennsylvania resident students or to provide services to  
19 Pennsylvania residents.

20 Section 6. This act shall take effect July 1, 2002, or  
21 immediately, whichever is later.
