AN ACT

1 Repealing certain acts and parts thereof relating to taxation.

2 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
3 hereby enacts as follows:

4 Section 1. Repeals.

5 The following acts and parts of acts are repealed:

6 Section LII of the act of March 30, 1811 (P.L.145, No.99),
7 entitled "An act to amend and consolidate the several acts
8 relating to the settlement of the public accounts and the
9 payment of the public monies, and for other purposes."

10 Act of March 24, 1818 (P.L.300, No.161), entitled "A
11 supplement to an act, entitled 'An act taxing certain offices.'"

12 Act of April 6, 1830 (P.L.272, No.157), entitled "An act for
13 the levy and collection of taxes upon proceedings in courts, and
14 in the offices of register and recorder, and for other
15 purposes."

16 Act of April 5, 1848 (P.L.335, No.266), entitled "An act
17 changing the time when certain officers shall make their

1 returns."

2 Section 7 of the act of April 30, 1864 (P.L.218, No.210),
3 entitled "An act imposing additional Taxes for State purposes,
4 and to abolish the Revenue Board."

5 Act of June 24, 1901 (P.L.596, No.290), entitled "An act to
6 tax all orders, checks, dividers, coupons, pass-books, or other
7 paper, representing wages or earnings of an employe, not paid in
8 cash to the employe or member of his family; to provide for a
9 report to the Auditor General of the same, and for the failure
10 to make reports."

11 Sections 706, 1206 and 1209 of the act of April 9, 1929
12 (P.L.343, No.176), known as The Fiscal Code.

13 Act of July 16, 1935 (P.L.1041, No.347), entitled "An act
14 authorizing the payment of certain State taxes in advance of the
15 due date thereof, allowing a discount where such taxes are paid
16 on or before a certain date, and conferring powers and imposing
17 duties on the Department of Revenue and the Board of Finance and
18 Revenue."

19 Act of July 16, 1935 (P.L.1043, No.348), entitled "An act
20 authorizing the payment of certain State taxes in advance of the
21 due date thereof, allowing various discounts where such taxes
22 are paid on or before certain dates, and conferring powers and
23 imposing duties on the Department of Revenue and the Board of
24 Finance and Revenue."

25 Section 2. Effective date.

26 This act shall take effect July 1, 2002, or immediately,
27 whichever is later.
