## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Establishing a select committee to review the current need for
- 2 an additional State veterans' home and to further identify
- 3 suitable sites for the possible establishment of a State
- 4 veterans' home in central Pennsylvania.
- 5 WHEREAS, There are approximately 1.3 million veterans
- 6 currently residing in Pennsylvania, and the population of
- 7 veterans is expected to exceed 1 million beyond the year 2010;
- 8 and
- 9 WHEREAS, The Commonwealth currently operates five State
- 10 veterans' homes and is presently constructing a sixth State
- 11 veterans' home in southeastern Pennsylvania; and
- 12 WHEREAS, The State veterans' home system is logistically
- 13 based to serve the nursing care needs of veterans in targeted
- 14 geographic areas of this Commonwealth; and
- 15 WHEREAS, Veterans in central Pennsylvania do not have a State

- 1 veterans' home in the geographic area between Hollidaysburg in
- 2 Blair County and Scranton in Lackawanna County; and
- 3 WHEREAS, The current waiting list for entry into a State
- 4 veterans' home appears to indicate the possible need for an
- 5 additional facility; and
- 6 WHEREAS, The establishment of a State veterans' home in
- 7 central Pennsylvania could greatly enhance the ability of our
- 8 State veterans' home system to serve veterans in the geographic
- 9 area closest to their families; therefore be it
- 10 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives establish a
- 11 select committee to review the current need for an additional
- 12 facility and to identify suitable sites for the possible
- 13 placement of a State veterans' home in central Pennsylvania; and
- 14 be it further
- 15 RESOLVED, That the committee consist of five members, two to
- 16 be appointed by the Majority Leader of the House of
- 17 Representatives, two to be appointed by the Minority Leader of
- 18 the House of Representatives and the other member to be the
- 19 chairman of the State Veterans' Commission; and be it further
- 20 RESOLVED, That the public members of the select committee be
- 21 entitled to reimbursement made in accordance with the
- 22 expenditure guidelines adopted by the House of Representatives
- 23 from accounts of the Chief Clerk for reasonable travel, lodging
- 24 and meal expenses incurred in the performance of their duties;
- 25 and be it further
- 26 RESOLVED, That the committee make a report of its findings
- 27 and recommendations to the House of Representatives on or before
- 28 November 30, 2002.
