A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing the 40th anniversary of the Teen Challenge Training 2 Center in Rehrersburg.
- 3 WHEREAS, The Teen Challenge Training Center is America's
- 4 largest and most successful drug and alcohol rehabilitation
- 5 program; and
- 6 WHEREAS, The training center began with eight men in a
- 7 farmhouse on a dairy farm in Rehrersburg; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Construction of the first housing unit began in July
- 9 1962; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Teen Challenge now encompasses more than 350 acres,
- 11 with 250 students and a dedicated staff of 70; and
- 12 WHEREAS, The Commonwealth of Pennsylvania through the
- 13 Department of Health and the Office of Drug and Alcohol Programs
- 14 licenses this 290-bed facility; and

- 1 WHEREAS, Teen Challenge offers an approach to drug and
- 2 alcohol rehabilitation that considers physical, psychological
- 3 and spiritual factors and features counseling and educational
- 4 and vocational training; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Youth and adults come to the training center, also
- 6 known as "God's Mountain," from programs across the United
- 7 States and from Teen Challenge International programs around the
- 8 world; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Teen Challenge, a faith-based organization, offers
- 10 academic and vocational training programs as well as general
- 11 education and remedial reading programs, with classes taught in
- 12 English or Spanish as needed; therefore be it
- RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives shall hereby
- 14 recognize the Teen Challenge Training Center in Rehrersburg on
- 15 its 40th anniversary and commend its success.
