## A RESOLUTION

- Designating the month of April 2002 as "Pennsylvania Organ and Tissue Donor Awareness Month."
- 3 WHEREAS, Organ and tissue transplantation has been recognized
- 4 as a corrective and lifesaving medical procedure; and
- 5 WHEREAS, This Commonwealth has 16 transplant centers and is
- 6 recognized as a world leader in organ and tissue
- 7 transplantation; and
- 8 WHEREAS, It is estimated that more than 80,000 people are
- 9 waiting for organ transplants in the United States; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Approximately 16 people die per day in the United
- 11 States while waiting for organ transplants; and

- 1 WHEREAS, State law enables citizens to donate their organs
- 2 and tissues through written statements and also allows relatives
- 3 to consent to the donation of organs and tissues of a deceased
- 4 family member; and
- 5 WHEREAS, A vital component of the continuation and
- 6 advancement of organ transplantation is the retrieval of donor
- 7 organs and tissues; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Improved surgical techniques and drugs to offset
- 9 rejection of organs have resulted in a high success rate; and
- 10 WHEREAS, The number of people in need of transplants far
- 11 exceeds the number of organs and the amount of tissue available;
- 12 therefore be it
- 13 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the
- 14 month of April 2002 as "Pennsylvania Organ and Tissue Donor
- 15 Awareness Month"; and be it further
- 16 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives encourage all
- 17 Pennsylvanians to carry donor cards or designate themselves as
- 18 an organ and tissue donor on their driver's license and discuss
- 19 this decision with family members and friends.
