A RESOLUTION

1 Designating the week of April 14, 2002, as "Medical Laboratory
2 Week" in Pennsylvania.

4 laboratory, including pathologists, medical technologists,
5 cytotechnologists, histotechnologists, medical laboratory
6 technicians, histologic technicians and phlebotomists, are
7 invaluable members of the patient's health care team; and

9 professionals, who perform and evaluate medical laboratory tests
10 to detect, diagnose, monitor treatment and help prevent
11 diseases, save countless lives each day; and

14 laboratories; and

15 WHEREAS, Laboratory medicine is an honorable profession,
