A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing the week of May 19 through 25, 2002, as "Emergency
2 Medical Services Week" in Pennsylvania.

3 WHEREAS, Emergency medical services personnel provide
4 indispensable services to the citizens of our Commonwealth and
5 our nation; and

6 WHEREAS, There are more than 750,000 emergency medical
7 services personnel nationwide; and

8 WHEREAS, This year's theme, "EMS: Help is a Heartbeat Away,"
9 emphasizes the responsiveness of emergency medical services and

1 the importance of a national 911 emergency telephone system; and

2 WHEREAS, This year's observance honors the heroic efforts of
3 the rescuers and medical teams who answered the call to the
4 Pentagon and the World Trade Center, especially those who made
5 the ultimate sacrifice, losing lives in the performance of their
6 duties; therefore be it

7 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize the
8 week of May 19 through 25, 2002, as "Emergency Medical Services
9 Week" in Pennsylvania.
