## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- Statutes, further providing for trains blocking crossings.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. Section 3713 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
- 6 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 7 § 3713. Railroad trains not to block crossings.
- 8 <u>(a) Offense.--</u>No person or government agency shall operate
- 9 any train in such a manner as to prevent vehicular use of any
- 10 roadway for a period of time in excess of five consecutive
- 11 minutes except under any of the following circumstances:
- 12 (1) When necessary to comply with signals affecting the
- 13 safety of the movement of trains.
- 14 (2) When necessary to avoid striking any object or
- 15 person on the track.
- 16 (3) When the train is disabled.
- 17 (4) When the train is in motion except while engaged in

- 1 switching operations.
- 2 (5) When there is no vehicular traffic waiting to use
- 3 the crossings.
- 4 (6) When necessary to comply with a governmental safety
- 5 regulation.
- 6 (b) Penalty. -- A person or government agency that violates
- 7 this section commits a summary offense and shall, upon
- 8 conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of \$100 for each five
- 9 minutes or portion thereof during which the violation occurs.
- 10 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
