11	(1) A person who violates subsection (a)(1) or (2) is
12	guilty of a summary offense for the first offense and upon
13	conviction thereof shall be sentenced to:
14	<u>(i)</u> pay a fine of not less than \$50 nor more than
15	\$300 [or to] <u>;</u>
16	<u>(ii)</u> imprisonment for not more than 90 days[, or
17	both.] <u>;</u>
18	(iii) NOT MORE THAN 90 days of community service; or
