## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, prohibiting the unauthorized taking of
- 3 newspapers from municipal recycling containers placed for
- 4 collection.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 8 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 9 § 3935. Theft from municipal recycling containers.
- 10 (a) Offense defined.--A person commits a summary offense if
- 11 the person, without prior authorization to do so, removes any
- 12 newspapers that other persons have sorted, bundled or baled for
- 13 recycling or placed in a municipal recycling container of
- 14 another person for collection by a municipality.
- 15 (b) Penalty.--A person who commits an offense under this
- 16 section shall be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than \$300
- 17 or, in the alternative and at the discretion of the court, to
- 18 perform community service for not fewer than eight hours nor

- 1 more than 16 hours.
- (c) Definition. -- As used in this section, the term 2
- 3 "municipal recycling container" means a container that is owned
- 4 by a municipality or a party under a contract with a
- 5 <u>municipality and is clearly marked as to ownership and supplied</u>
- 6 to a person for the deposit of newspapers and other materials to
- 7 <u>be collected</u>.
- Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days. 8
