Section 1104(b)(3) of Title 65 of the 6 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended to read: 8 Statement of financial interests required to be filed. 9 * * * 10 (b) Candidate.--11 [No] If a petition to appear on the ballot for 12 13 election [shall be accepted by] is filed with the respective 14 State or local election officials [unless] and the petition 15 [has] does not have appended thereto a statement of financial 16 interests as set forth in paragraphs (1) and (2)[. Failure to 17 file the statement in accordance with the provisions of this

chapter shall, in addition to any other penalties provided,

- be a fatal defect to a petition to appear on the ballot.],

- 3 <u>interests after the last day for filing a petition if in the</u>
- 4 <u>discretion of the Commonwealth Court in the case of a</u>
- 5 <u>petition for a State office or in the discretion of the</u>
- 6 county court of common pleas in the case of a petition for a
- 7 <u>county or local office the court finds that there was a good</u>
- 8 <u>faith effort to timely file the statement and that the</u>
- 9 <u>statement has since been filed as set forth in paragraphs (1)</u>
