## AN ACT

- 1 Providing for grants to public, private and parochial schools to
- 2 purchase automated external defibrillators; providing for
- powers and duties of the Department of Health; and making an
- 4 appropriation.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Purpose.
- 8 The purpose of this act is to encourage public, private and
- 9 parochial schools to purchase automated external defibrillators
- 10 because schools are gathering places for the public and
- 11 automated external defibrillators could be useful at school and
- 12 community events to safeguard the lives of citizens.
- 13 Section 2. Grants.
- 14 The Department of Health is authorized to make grants to
- 15 school districts and private and parochial schools enrolling
- 16 children up through grade 12 for the purchase price of a maximum
- 17 of two automated external defibrillators for use in each
- 18 district or school. The grant amounts shall not exceed 50% or
- 19 \$1,500 of the purchase price of each automated external

- 1 defibrillator.
- 2 Section 3. Terms of grants.
- 3 The recipients of a grant shall enter into an agreement with
- 4 the Department of Health. The agreement shall include, but not
- 5 be limited to, the following terms and conditions:
- 6 (1) Expected automated external defibrillator users
  7 shall be trained to utilize available means to immediately
- 8 contact and activate the emergency medical services system.
- 9 (2) Expected automated external defibrillator users
- shall be trained in cardiopulmonary resuscitation through a
- 11 course of instruction provided by the American Red Cross or
- 12 the American Heart Association or through an equivalent
- 13 course of instruction approved by the Department of Health in
- consultation with a technical committee of the Pennsylvania
- 15 Emergency Health Services Council.
- 16 (3) Expected automated external defibrillator users
- shall complete training in the use of an automated external
- defibrillator through a course of instruction provided by the
- 19 American Red Cross or the American Heart Association or
- 20 through an equivalent course of instruction approved by the
- 21 Department of Health in consultation with a technical
- 22 committee of the Pennsylvania Emergency Health Services
- 23 Council.
- 24 (4) Recipient districts and schools shall maintain and
- 25 test the automated external defibrillator according to the
- 26 manufacturer's operational guidelines.
- 27 (5) Recipient districts and schools shall notify
- 28 emergency medical services personnel of the presence of an
- 29 automated external defibrillator and assure that any
- 30 appropriate data or information is made available to

- 1 emergency medical services personnel or other health care
- 2 providers as requested.
- 3 Section 4. Regulations.
- 4 The Department of Health is authorized to promulgate rules
- 5 and regulations to carry out the provisions of this act.
- 6 Section 5. Appropriation.
- 7 The sum of \$1,503,000, or as much thereof as may be
- 8 necessary, is hereby appropriated to the Department of Health to
- 9 carry out the provisions of this act.
- 10 Section 6. Effective date.
- 11 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
