## AN ACT

Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain 3 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the 5 laws relating thereto," further providing for certificates qualifying persons to teach and for kinds of State certificates; and providing for a K-3 certification and 7 8 certain loan forgiveness. The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 10 hereby enacts as follows: 11 Section 1. Section 1201 of the act of March 10, 1949 12 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, 13 amended January 14, 1970 (1969, P.L.468, No.192), is amended to 14 read: 15 Section 1201. Certificates Qualifying Persons to Teach. --16 Only those persons holding one of the following certificates 17 shall be qualified to teach in the public schools of this 18 Commonwealth--(1) Permanent college certificate, (2) provisional college certificate, (3) normal school diploma, (4) normal 19 school certificate, (5) special permanent certificate, (6) 20

- 1 special temporary certificate, (7) permanent State certificate,
- 2 (8) certificates which are permanent licenses to teach by virtue
- 3 of the provisions of section one thousand three hundred eight of
- 4 the act, approved the eighteenth day of May, one thousand nine
- 5 hundred eleven (Pamphlet Laws 309), as amended, which is
- 6 repealed hereby, [or] (9) K-3 certificate or (10) such other
- 7 kinds of certificates as are issued under the standards
- 8 prescribed by the State Board of Education. The State Board of
- 9 Education shall also provide for issuance of certificates by
- 10 district superintendents to meet such emergencies or shortage of
- 11 teachers as may occur.
- 12 Section 2. Section 1203 of the act is amended to read:
- 13 Section 1203. Kinds of State Certificates. -- State
- 14 certificates hereafter granted shall include the following:
- 15 Provisional College Certificates,
- 16 Permanent College Certificates,
- 17 Certificates issued by other states and validated by the
- 18 Superintendent of Public Instruction,
- 19 Special Temporary Certificates,
- 20 Special Permanent Certificates,
- 21 <u>K-3 Certificates</u>.
- 22 All persons receiving any of such certificates shall have
- 23 qualifications not less than graduation from a State Teachers'
- 24 College of this Commonwealth, or equivalent training.
- 25 Every college certificate shall set forth the names of the
- 26 college or university from which its holder was graduated. State
- 27 certificates shall entitle their holders to teach in every part
- 28 of this Commonwealth for the terms herein specified.
- 29 Section 3. The act is amended by adding a section to read:
- 30 Section 1216. K-3 Certificates; Loan Forgiveness.--(a) The

- 1 <u>Secretary of Education shall issue a K-3 certificate to every</u>
- 2 person who presents to him satisfactory evidence of good moral
- 3 character, of being a graduate of an approved college or
- 4 <u>university</u>, a recommendation from the college or university that
- 5 the person receive the K-3 certification, and successful
- 6 <u>experience of one year in a student teaching instructional</u>
- 7 internship in a public school classroom from kindergarten
- 8 through third grade in this Commonwealth.
- 9 (b) (1) A person who earned at least a 3.00 grade point
- 10 average upon graduation from an approved college or university,
- 11 has borrowed moneys through the Guaranteed Student Loan Programs
- 12 <u>administered by the Pennsylvania Higher Education Assistance</u>
- 13 Agency, has received a K-3 certificate under this section, is
- 14 employed as a full-time teacher in a public school classroom
- 15 from kindergarten through third grade in this Commonwealth, and
- 16 agrees to teach in a public school classroom from kindergarten
- 17 through third grade in this Commonwealth for a period of five
- 18 (5) years shall be eliqible for payment by the agency of a
- 19 portion of that debt incurred by the person.
- 20 (2) For each academic year that the person is employed as a
- 21 <u>full-time teacher in a public school classroom from kindergarten</u>
- 22 through third grade in this Commonwealth, the agency may forgive
- 23 a proportional part of the person's loan so that the loan may be
- 24 entirely forgiven over five (5) years of full-time teaching. No
- 25 more than five thousand dollars (\$5,000) shall be forgiven in
- 26 any year and no more than twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000)
- 27 shall be forgiven for any person. Payments shall be made in
- 28 accordance with the procedures established by the agency.
- 29 (c) This section shall not apply to any person who has a
- 30 <u>certificate from the Department of Ed</u>ucation on the effective

- 1 date of this section.
- 2 Section 4. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
