A RESOLUTION

1 Designating July 27, 2001, as "Korean War Armistice Day" in  
2 Pennsylvania and urging all government agencies and the  
3 citizens of Pennsylvania to fly the American flag at half-  
4 staff on July 27, 2001, in honor of all Americans who bravely  
5 served, made the ultimate sacrifice or who are listed as  
6 missing in action as a result of the Korean War.

7 WHEREAS, The United States of America was engaged in the  
8 Korean War from 1950 through 1955; and

9 WHEREAS, Some have referred to the Korean War as the  
10 "Forgotten War"; and

11 WHEREAS, Many Americans placed themselves at great risk and  
12 made great personal sacrifices during the Korean War, resulting  
13 in the loss of more than 54,000 American lives and more than  
14 8,000 Americans listed as missing in action; and

15 WHEREAS, These brave Americans made these sacrifices on  
16 behalf of their country and to defend its interests; therefore  
17 be it

18 RESOLVED, That the Senate designate July 27, 2001, as "Korean

1 War Armistice Day" in Pennsylvania; and be it further

2       RESOLVED, That the Senate urge all government agencies and  
3 the citizens of Pennsylvania to fly the American flag at half-  
4 staff on July 27, 2001, in honor of and in tribute to all  
5 Americans who served, lost their lives or are listed as missing  
6 in action as a result of the Korean War.
