- 16 § 1371. Definitions.
- 17 The following words and phrases when used in this subchapter
- 18 shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the

- 1 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 2 "Municipality." A county, city, borough, incorporated town
- 3 or township.
- 4 § 1372. Bonds.
- 5 No municipality shall have the authority to require the
- 6 posting of a bond or other financial security as a precondition
- 7 for erecting or posting signs on private property seeking to
- 8 influence the outcome of an election.
- 9 § 1373. Candidate signs.
- 10 No municipality may require the removal from private property
- 11 of signs seeking to influence the outcome of an election prior
- 12 to the day after the general, municipal or special election
- 13 sought to be influenced.
- 14 § 1374. Referendum signs.
- No municipality may require the removal from private property
- 16 of signs seeking to influence the outcome of a referendum prior
- 17 to the day after the primary, general, municipal or special
- 18 election at which the referendum question is presented to the
- 19 electorate.
- 20 § 1375. Limitation.
- 21 Nothing contained in this subchapter shall limit the right of
- 22 a municipality to impose reasonable regulations on the size or
- 23 illumination of signs or to require the removal of signs from
- 24 locations in which they create an obstruction to traffic.
- 25 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
