10	(a) EstablishmentA Municipal Authority Ombudsman is
11	established within the Center for Local Government of the
12	Department of Community and Economic Development. The ombudsman
13	shall assist citizens who have complaints against municipal
14	authorities by:
15	(1) Taking the complaints.
16	(2) Referring investigation of the complaints to the
17	appropriate responsible parties.
18	(3) Explaining relevant law and the options available to

- 2 (b) Eligibility.--The Municipal Authority Ombudsman must be
- 3 <u>a person who is an employee of the Commonwealth.</u>
