16	Section 817.1. Employment of health care practitioners.	
17	<u>A health care practitioner may practice the healing arts in</u>	
18	any of the following manners:	<-
19	(1) As an employee of another individual or person,	
20	regardless of the licensure or permit status of the employer	
21	<u>or any person with a legal or an equitable interest in the</u>

2	(2) As an independent contractor with another individual	
3	or person, regardless of the licensure or permit status of	
4	the other party to the contract or any person with a legal or	
5	an equitable interest in the other party. A HEALTH CARE	<—
6	FACILITY LICENSED PURSUANT TO THIS ACT AS AN EMPLOYEE OR	
7	INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR. A HEALTH CARE FACILITY SHALL NOT	
8	INTERFERE WITH A HEALTH CARE PRACTITIONER'S PROFESSIONAL	
9	MEDICAL OR ETHICAL JUDGMENT.	
10	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
