AN ACT

- 1 Repealing the act of May 21, 1943 (P.L.271, No.124), entitled 2 "An act validating certain expenditures heretofore made by
- 3 county commissioners in order to furnish filing cabinets or
- 4 other office equipment to rationing boards."
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. The act of May 21, 1943 (P.L.271, No.124),
- 8 entitled "An act validating certain expenditures heretofore made
- 9 by county commissioners in order to furnish filing cabinets or
- 10 other office equipment to rationing boards," is repealed.
- 11 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
