## AN ACT

- 1 Requiring notification of condemnation proceedings by public
- 2 utilities and pipeline companies.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. Notification of condemnation.
- 6 Except as otherwise provided in section 2, a public utility
- 7 or pipeline company possessing the authority to condemn real
- 8 property shall provide written notice of its intent to condemn
- 9 any real property to the governing bodies of all municipalities
- 10 in which the real property is located at least 120 days prior to
- 11 initiating any action under the act of June 22, 1964 (Sp.Sess.,
- 12 P.L.84, No.6), known as the Eminent Domain Code.
- 13 Section 2. Exception.
- 14 A public utility or pipeline company is not required to
- 15 provide the notice under section 1 when it acts in response to
- 16 an emergency.
- 17 Section 3. Effective date.

1 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
