AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of November 24, 1999 (P.L.884, No.54), entitled 2 "An act relating to the licensure and regulation of pediatric
- 3 extended care centers in this Commonwealth, providing for
- 4 definitions; and further providing for regulations.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Section 3 of the act of November 24, 1999
- 8 (P.L.884, No.54), known as the Prescribed Pediatric Extended
- 9 Care Centers Act, is amended by adding definitions to read:
- 10 Section 3. Definitions.
- 11 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
- 12 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 13 context clearly indicates otherwise:

- 15 <u>"Medical assistance." The State program of medical</u>
- 16 assistance established under subdivision (f) of Article IV of
- 17 the act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), known as the Public

- 1 Welfare Code.

- 3 <u>"Necessary transportation." Transportation reasonably</u>
- 4 <u>necessary or required to transport a medically dependent or</u>
- 5 technologically dependent child, taking into consideration the
- 6 medical condition or other needs of the child. Necessary
- 7 <u>transportation may include ambulance transportation when the</u>
- 8 condition of the child makes ambulance service medically
- 9 <u>necessary</u>.

- 11 <u>"Transportation zone." The geographical area comprised of</u>
- 12 the county in which a PECC is physically located, each adjoining
- 13 county and each county immediately contiguous to the adjoining
- 14 counties.
- 15 Section 2. Section 15(b) of the act is amended by adding a
- 16 paragraph to read:
- 17 Section 15. Regulations.

- 19 (b) Requirements.--
- 20 * * *
- 21 (1.1) The PECC shall provide, directly or through other
- arrangements, necessary transportation to and from the PECC
- for medically dependent or technologically dependent children
- 24 who are eligible for medical assistance and live in the
- 25 transportation zone in which the PECC is located. The
- department shall pay the costs of the transportation.

- 28 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
