AN ACT

1 Repealing the act of December 1, 1965 (P.L.977, No.357),
2 entitled "An act authorizing cities of the first class and
3 counties of the first class to adopt the food stamp program
4 and providing for payment of the costs of administration
5 thereof."

6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
7 hereby enacts as follows:

8 Section 1. The act of December 1, 1965 (P.L.977, No.357),
9 entitled "An act authorizing cities of the first class and
10 counties of the first class to adopt the food stamp program and
11 providing for payment of the costs of administration thereof,"
12 is repealed.

13 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
