AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 53 (Municipalities Generally) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, further providing for form and
- adoption of budget in cities of the second class.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 3016 of Title 53 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 8 § 3016. Form and adoption of budget.
- 9 <u>(a) General rule.--</u>The budget shall be in the form required
- 10 by council and shall have appended to it a detailed analysis of
- 11 the various items of expenditure and revenue. The budget as
- 12 submitted and adopted shall be balanced. Council may reduce any
- 13 item or items in the executive's (mayor's) budget by a vote of a
- 14 majority of the council, but an increase in any item or items
- 15 therein shall become effective only upon an affirmative vote of
- 16 a majority plus one of the members of council. Council shall,

- 1 upon the introduction of the proposed budget, fix a date for
- 2 adoption which shall except as otherwise provided be not later
- 3 than December 31 immediately following.
- 4 (b) Second class cities. -- A balanced budget of ANY HOME RULE <--
- 5 MUNICIPALITY WHICH BASED ON ITS POPULATION QUALIFIES AS a city
- 6 of the second class and OR any authority having board members <--
- 7 appointed by any elected official of a THE city of the second <-
- 8 <u>class shall not include projected revenue that in order to be</u>
- 9 <u>collected requires the enactment by the General Assembly of new</u>
- 10 taxing powers.
- 11 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
