4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania	
5	hereby enacts as follows:	
6	Section 1. (a) The following sums, or as much thereof as	
7	may be necessary, are hereby appropriated to the Trustees of the	
8	University of Pennsylvania for the fiscal year July 1, 2004, to	
9	June 30, 2005, for the purposes and in the amounts as shown:	
10	(1) For dental clinics \$1,029,000	
11	(2) For instruction in the Doctor of Medicine	
12	program	
13	(3) For veterinary activities	<
14	(3) FOR VETERINARY ACTIVITIES	<
15	(4) For cardiovascular studies 1,520,000	

1 (b) The sum of \$225,000 is hereby appropriated to the Trustees of the University of Pennsylvania for the fiscal year 2 3 July 1, 2004, to June 30, 2005, for the general maintenance of 4 the University of Pennsylvania Museum and the purchase of such 5 apparatus and equipment as the trustees may deem necessary for the best interest of the University of Pennsylvania Museum. 6 7 Section 2. (a) Payments to the University of Pennsylvania on account of the appropriations for the items provided in 8 section 1(a) shall be made quarterly by the Secretary of 9 Education on the basis of costs during the fiscal year and shall 10 11 be conditioned on continuing authority for inclusion on the Board of Trustees of the University of Pennsylvania of a minimum 12 13 of four persons who are not elected officials and who are 14 appointed by the President pro tempore of the Senate, the 15 Minority Leader of the Senate, the Speaker of the House of 16 Representatives and the Minority Leader of the House of 17 Representatives for terms of office coterminous with that of the 18 respective appointing authority; and shall be further 19 conditioned on these appointees receiving full voting rights as 20 members of the board of trustees.

(b) The University of Pennsylvania shall provide full, complete and accurate information as may be required by the Department of Education or the chairman or the minority chairman of the Appropriations Committee of the Senate or the chairman or the minority chairman of the Appropriations Committee of the House of Representatives.

(c) The University of Pennsylvania shall report its revenues and expenditures and present its financial statements in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles and procedures for educational institutions as set forth in the 20040H2535B4080 - 2 - "Higher Education Finance Manual (1975)" and the "Commonwealth
of Pennsylvania Budget Instructions for the State System of
Higher Education, State-Related Universities and Non-State Related Colleges and Universities."

5 (d) The Trustees of the University of Pennsylvania shall report on forms provided by the Department of Education to both 6 7 the chairman and minority chairman of the Appropriations Committee of the Senate and the chairman and minority chairman 8 9 of the Appropriations Committee of the House of Representatives 10 by September 30, 2005, on how State-appropriated funds were 11 expended for fiscal year 2004-2005 to reduce the costs to Pennsylvania resident students or to provide services to 12 13 Pennsylvania residents.

14 Section 3. (a) Payments to the University of Pennsylvania 15 Museum on account of the appropriation provided in section 1(b) 16 shall be made quarterly by the Executive Director of the 17 Pennsylvania Historical and Museum Commission.

18 (b) The Trustees of the University of Pennsylvania shall 19 provide full, complete and accurate information as may be 20 required by the Pennsylvania Historical and Museum Commission or 21 the chairman or the minority chairman of the Appropriations 22 Committee of the Senate or the chairman or the minority chairman 23 of the Appropriations Committee of the House of Representatives. SECTION 4. AS A CONDITION OF ACCEPTING FUNDS UNDER SECTION 24 25 1(A)(2), THE UNIVERSITY OF PENNSYLVANIA AGREES TO ATTEND AND 26 PARTICIPATE IN AN INITIAL AND TWO FOLLOW-UP MEETINGS AT MUTUALLY CONVENIENT TIMES AND PLACES DURING THE 2004-2005 FISCAL YEAR TO 27 28 REVIEW EXISTING EFFORTS AND TO DISCUSS, ANALYZE AND RECOMMEND 29 WAYS THAT MEDICAL SCHOOLS AND THE COMMONWEALTH CAN WORK TOGETHER 30 TO INCREASE THE NUMBER AND PERCENTAGE OF MEDICAL STUDENTS WHO 20040H2535B4080 - 3 -

1 WILL PRACTICE IN MEDICALLY UNDERSERVED AREAS OR HEALTH 2 PROFESSIONAL SHORTAGE AREAS WITHIN THIS COMMONWEALTH. MEETINGS 3 SHALL INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING INDIVIDUALS: 4 (1) A REPRESENTATIVE OF THE GOVERNOR. 5 (2) A REPRESENTATIVE OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH. 6 (3) A REPRESENTATIVE OF THE PENNSYLVANIA AREA HEALTH 7 EDUCATION CENTER. 8 (4) FOUR LEGISLATIVE APPOINTEES AS FOLLOWS: 9 (I) A SENATOR APPOINTED BY THE PRESIDENT PRO TEMPORE 10 OF THE SENATE. 11 (II) A SENATOR APPOINTED BY THE MINORITY LEADER OF 12 THE SENATE. 13 (III) A MEMBER OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES APPOINTED BY THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES. 14 15 (IV) A MEMBER OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 16 APPOINTED BY THE MINORITY LEADER OF THE HOUSE OF 17 REPRESENTATIVES. 18 (5) REPRESENTATIVES FROM OTHER MEDICAL SCHOOLS COVERED 19 BY SIMILAR LEGISLATIVE PROVISIONS. 20 Section 4 5. This act shall take effect July 1, 2004, or <---21 immediately, whichever is later.
