AN ACT

- 1 Making an appropriation to The Children's Institute, Pittsburgh,
- 2 for treatment and rehabilitation of certain persons with
- 3 disabling diseases.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. The sum of \$781,000 \\$970,000 is hereby
- 7 appropriated to The Children's Institute, Pittsburgh, for the
- 8 fiscal year July 1, 2004, to June 30, 2005, for the treatment
- 9 and rehabilitation of children and young adults with disabling
- 10 diseases. Payment of this appropriation shall be made by the
- 11 Secretary of Health in equal quarterly payments.
- 12 Section 2. The Children's Institute shall provide full,
- 13 complete and accurate information as may be required by the
- 14 Department of Health or the chairman or the minority chairman of
- 15 the Appropriations Committee of the Senate or the chairman or
- 16 the minority chairman of the Appropriations Committee of the
- 17 House of Representatives.

- 1 Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2004, or
- 2 immediately, whichever is later.
