## AN ACT

- Amending the act of May 17, 1921 (P.L.682, No.284), entitled "An 2 act relating to insurance; amending, revising, and 3 consolidating the law providing for the incorporation of insurance companies, and the regulation, supervision, and 5 protection of home and foreign insurance companies, Lloyds associations, reciprocal and inter-insurance exchanges, and 7 fire insurance rating bureaus, and the regulation and 8 supervision of insurance carried by such companies, associations, and exchanges, including insurance carried by 9 10 the State Workmen's Insurance Fund; providing penalties; and repealing existing laws," providing for coverage for breast 11 12 cancer screening examinations.
- 13 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 14 hereby enacts as follows:
- 15 Section 1. Section 632 of the act of May 17, 1921 (P.L.682,
- 16 No.284), known as The Insurance Company Law of 1921, amended
- 17 December 15, 1992 (P.L.1129, No.148), is amended to read:
- 18 Section 632. Coverage for [Mammographic] Breast Cancer
- 19 <u>Screening Examinations.--All group or individual health or</u>

- 1 sickness or accident insurance policies providing hospital or
- 2 medical/surgical coverage and all group or individual subscriber
- 3 contracts or certificates issued by any entity subject to 40
- 4 Pa.C.S. Ch. 61 (relating to hospital plan corporations) or 63
- 5 (relating to professional health services plan corporations),
- 6 this act, the act of December 29, 1972 (P.L.1701, No.364), known
- 7 as the "Health Maintenance Organization Act," the act of July
- 8 29, 1977 (P.L.105, No.38), known as the "Fraternal Benefit
- 9 Society Code, " or an employe welfare benefit plan as defined in
- 10 section 3 of the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974
- 11 (Public Law 93-406, 29 U.S.C. § 1001 et seq.) providing hospital
- 12 or medical/surgical coverage shall also provide coverage for
- 13 [mammographic examinations] breast cancer screening
- 14 <u>examinations</u>. The minimum coverage required shall include all
- 15 costs associated with [a mammogram] mammography, ultrasound,
- 16 <u>sonogram and magnetic resonance imaging testing</u> every year for
- 17 women [40] 20 years of age or older. [and with any mammogram
- 18 based on a physician's recommendation for women under 40 years
- 19 of age.] Prior to payment for a screening mammogram, insurers
- 20 shall verify that the screening mammography service provider is
- 21 properly licensed by the department in accordance with the act
- 22 of July 9, 1992 (P.L.449, No.93), known as the "Mammography
- 23 Quality Assurance Act." Nothing in this section shall be
- 24 construed to require an insurer to cover the surgical procedure
- 25 known as mastectomy or to prevent application of deductible or
- 26 copayment provisions contained in the policy or plan.
- 27 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
