8	Section 1. Section 2162 of Title 53 of the Pennsylvania
9	Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a definition to read:
10	§ 2162. Definitions.
11	The following words and phrases when used in this subchapter
12	shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
13	context clearly indicates otherwise:
14	"Applicant." A person who has applied to a school for basic
15	police education and training.

17	Section 2. Section 2164 of Title 53 is amended by adding a

1 paragraph to read:

2 § 2164. Powers and duties of commission.

3 The powers and duties of the commission shall be as follows:
4 * * *

5 (16) To require an applicant to submit fingerprints for examination by the Pennsylvania State Police and the Federal 6 7 Bureau of Investigation to determine if the applicant has 8 been convicted of a felony or serious misdemeanor or if the 9 applicant is a wanted person. Fingerprinting shall be conducted by the Pennsylvania State Police or a local law 10 11 enforcement agency capable of submitting the fingerprints 12 electronically to the Pennsylvania State Police utilizing the 13 Federal Automated Fingerprinting Identification System or in 14 a manner and in such form as may be provided by the Pennsylvania State Police. The commissioner may waive the 15 16 Federal Bureau of Investigation examination. The applicant shall pay any fee assessed by the Pennsylvania State Police 17 18 or a local law enforcement agency and such fee may not exceed the actual cost incurred in conducting the fingerprinting and 19 20 background check. The submission of fingerprints and the 21 examination thereof, unless waived by the commissioner, shall 22 be completed prior to any firearms or tactic training at any 23 school. Criminal history record information obtained pursuant to this section shall be governed by 18 Pa.C.S. Ch. 91 2.4 25 (relating to criminal history record information), except that for purposes of this section, the administrator of a 26 27 school or the administrator's designee shall be permitted to 28 have access to outstanding warrant information contained in 29 the applicant's Federal or State criminal history record.
