AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of August 26, 1971 (P.L.351, No.91), entitled
 - "An act providing for a State Lottery and administration
- thereof; authorizing the creation of a State Lottery
- 4 Commission; prescribing its powers and duties; disposition of
- 5 funds; violations and penalties therefor; exemption of prizes
- 6 from State and local taxation and making an appropriation,"
- 7 providing for confidentiality of prize winners' names and
- 8 addresses.
- 9 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 10 hereby enacts as follows:
- 11 Section 1. The act of August 26, 1971 (P.L.351, No.91),
- 12 known as the State Lottery Law, is amended by adding a section
- 13 to read:
- 14 <u>Section 315</u>. <u>Confidentiality</u>.
- 15 The name and address of any lottery prize winner under this
- 16 chapter shall not be disclosed to the public by the divsion, the
- 17 Department of Revenue or any officer, agent or employee of the
- 18 Commonwealth unless permission is given by the prize winner.
- 19 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
