- 7 support of Delta's National Thrust by participating in the March
- 8 8 "International Day of Service"; and
- 9 WHEREAS, To initiate this special day, students are
- 10 participating in an HIV/AIDS awareness poster contest; and
- 11 WHEREAS, The winners' art will be displayed at area public
- 12 libraries; and
- 13 WHEREAS, The Alumnae Chapter is holding a workshop session
- 14 for the youths of the Community Intensive Supervision Program,
- 15 targeting African-American males to educate and inform them
- 16 about the consequences of high-risk behavior; and
