3 than any other individual.

4 WHEREAS, The Honorable Robert C. Jubelirer was elected to the  
5 Senate in 1975 and has served continuously since that time; and

6 WHEREAS, Senator Jubelirer served as Majority Leader of the  
7 Senate from 1981 to 1984, as President pro tempore from 1985 to  
8 1992 and from 1995 to the present, as Minority Leader in 1993  
9 and 1994 and as Lieutenant Governor from October 5, 2001, to  
10 January 21, 2002; and

11 WHEREAS, Senator Jubelirer's senatorial leadership

1 establishes a record of service in this august body; and

2 WHEREAS, In the Senate, Senator Jubelirer has been a  
3 proponent and dedicated leader on numerous issues, including  
4 open government, senior citizen legislation, education reform,  
5 property tax relief and rural opportunity; and

6 WHEREAS, Senator Jubelirer demonstrates exemplary civic  
7 service as chairman of the Blair County Multiple Sclerosis  
8 Society and as a member of the Commonwealth's Tuition Account  
9 Program (TAP) Board and the Advisory Council of the  
10 Hollidaysburg Veterans Home; and

11 WHEREAS, Senator Jubelirer has received many commendations  
12 and awards for his public service, including the Champion of  
13 Good Government Award from Common Cause; therefore be it

14 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives honor Senator
