- 1 Observing the week of June 5 through 12, 2004, as "National
- 2 NeighborWorks Week" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, "National NeighborWorks Week" was initiated in 1984
- 4 by a resolution cosponsored by more than 240 members of the
- 5 Congress of the United States and signed by President Ronald
- 6 Reagan; and
- WHEREAS, Formally introduced in 1986, "National NeighborWorks"
- 8 Week" is observed as an annual weeklong celebration beginning on
- 9 the first Saturday in June; and
- 10 WHEREAS, "National NeighborWorks Week" celebrates
- 11 neighborhood pride and unity and supports housing and community
- 12 development initiatives in more than 2,500 urban, suburban and
- 13 rural communities across the country; and
- 14 WHEREAS, "National NeighborWorks Week" celebrates the efforts
- 15 of local nonprofit organizations, public-private partnerships
- 16 and volunteers to assist homeowners, revitalize neighborhoods,
- 17 and create healthier communities; and

- 1 WHEREAS, Rural Opportunities, Inc., a NeighborWorks
- 2 organization, has worked throughout this Commonwealth for 25
- 3 years; therefore be it
- 4 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives observe the week
- 5 of June 5 through 12, 2004, as "National NeighborWorks Week" in
- 6 Pennsylvania.
