AN ACT

1	Amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), entitled
2	"An act providing for and reorganizing the conduct of the
3	executive and administrative work of the Commonwealth by the
4	Executive Department thereof and the administrative
5	departments, boards, commissions, and officers thereof,
б	including the boards of trustees of State Normal Schools, or
7	Teachers Colleges; abolishing, creating, reorganizing or
8	authorizing the reorganization of certain administrative
9	departments, boards, and commissions; defining the powers and
10	duties of the Governor and other executive and administrative
11	officers, and of the several administrative departments,
12	boards, commissions, and officers; fixing the salaries of the
13	Governor, Lieutenant Governor, and certain other executive
14	and administrative officers; providing for the appointment of
15	certain administrative officers, and of all deputies and
16	other assistants and employes in certain departments, boards,
17	and commissions; and prescribing the manner in which the
18	number and compensation of the deputies and all other
19	assistants and employes of certain departments, boards and
20	commissions shall be determined, " providing for a Low-Income
21	Home Energy Assistance Block Grant.
22	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
23	hereby enacts as follows:

24 Section 1. The act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), known 25 as The Administrative Code of 1929, is amended by adding a

27 <u>Section 626. Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Block</u>

1	<u>Grant(a) The Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Block Grant</u>
2	(LIHEABG) is to help lessen the impact of the high cost of
3	energy on low-income families and individuals, including energy
4	efficiency grants for low-income dwellings. No less than fifteen
5	per centum (15%) of all LIHEABG funds received shall be used for
6	weatherization.
7	(b) The Department of Community and Economic Development
8	shall adopt regulations regarding the weatherization
9	requirements of subsection (a) after consultation with the
10	Department of Public Welfare.
11	(c) Unexpended LIHEABG weatherization funds which would
12	result in LIHEABG funds being returned to the Federal Department
13	of Health and Human Services may be spent for assistance grants
14	at the discretion of the Secretary of the Budget. The Secretary
15	of the Budget shall notify the chairman and minority chairman of
16	the Appropriations Committee of the Senate and the chairman and
17	the minority chairman of the Appropriations Committee of the
18	House of Representatives of the intent to reallocate any such
19	funds ten days prior to any reallocation.
20	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
