- 10 The following words and phrases when used in this chapter
- 11 shall have, unless the context clearly indicates otherwise, the
- 12 meanings given to them in this section:

- "Delinquent act."
- 15 (1) The term means an act designated a crime under the
- law of this Commonwealth, or of another state if the act
- 17 occurred in that state, or under Federal law, or under local
- 18 ordinances or an act which constitutes indirect criminal

Ch. 61 (relating to protection from 2 abuse). 3 (2) The term shall not include: 4 (i) The crime of murder. 5 (ii) Any of the following prohibited conduct where the child was 15 years of age or older at the time of the 6 7 alleged conduct and a deadly weapon as defined in 18 Pa.C.S. § 2301 (relating to definitions) was used during 8 the commission of the offense which, if committed by an 9 adult, would be classified as: 10 11 [(A) Rape as defined in 18 Pa.C.S. § 3121 12 (relating to rape). 13 (B) Involuntary deviate sexual intercourse as defined in 18 Pa.C.S. § 3123 (relating to involuntary 14 15 deviate sexual intercourse).] (C) Aggravated assault as defined in 18 Pa.C.S. 16 17 § 2702(a)(1) or (2) (relating to aggravated assault). 18 Robbery as defined in 18 Pa.C.S. § 19 3701(a)(1)(i), (ii) or (iii) (relating to robbery). 20 (E) Robbery of motor vehicle as defined in 18 21 Pa.C.S. § 3702 (relating to robbery of motor 22 vehicle). 23 (F) Aggravated indecent assault as defined in 18 24 Pa.C.S. § 3125 (relating to aggravated indecent 25 assault). 26 (G) Kidnapping as defined in 18 Pa.C.S. § 2901 27 (relating to kidnapping). 28 (H) Voluntary manslaughter. An attempt, conspiracy or solicitation to 29 30 commit murder or any of these crimes as provided in

8	which, if committed by an adult, would be classified as:
9	[(A) Rape as defined in 18 Pa.C.S. § 3121.
10	(B) Involuntary deviate sexual intercourse as
11	defined in 18 Pa.C.S. § 3123.]
12	(C) Robbery as defined in 18 Pa.C.S. §
13	3701(a)(1)(i), (ii) or (iii).
14	(D) Robbery of motor vehicle as defined in 18
15	Pa.C.S. § 3702.
16	(E) Aggravated indecent assault as defined in 18
17	Pa.C.S. § 3125.
18	(F) Kidnapping as defined in 18 Pa.C.S. § 2901.
19	(G) Voluntary manslaughter.
20	(H) An attempt, conspiracy or solicitation to
21	commit murder or any of these crimes as provided in
22	18 Pa.C.S. §§ 901, 902 and 903.
23	(iv) Summary offenses, unless the child fails to
24	comply with a lawful sentence imposed thereunder, in
25	which event notice of such fact shall be certified to the
26	court.
27	(v) A crime committed by a child who has been found
28	guilty in a criminal proceeding for other than a summary
29	offense.
30	(vi) The crime of rape as defined in 18 Pa.C.S. §

- (vii) The crime of involuntary deviate sexual 2
- intercourse as defined in 18 Pa.C.S. § 3123 (relating to 3
- involuntary deviate sexual intercourse). 4

- 6 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
