## AN ACT

Requirement. 10 11 (b) Grounds for denying employment. --(1) Except as provided in section 6356 (relating to
- (1) Except as provided in section 6356 (relating to exceptions), an administrator shall not hire an applicant if the department verifies that the applicant is named as the perpetrator of a founded report or is named as the individual responsible for injury or abuse in a founded report for school employee. [No]

  (2) Except as provided in paragraph (3), no individual

- 1 who is a school employee on the effective date of this
- 2 subchapter shall be required to obtain an official clearance
- 3 statement under subsection (a)(1) as a condition of continued
- 4 employment.
- 5 (3) Nothing in this section shall prevent a private
- 6 school from requiring an employee to obtain an official
- 7 <u>clearance statement as a condition of continued employment.</u>

- 9 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
