## AN ACT

- 8 Section 1. Redesignating the Clairton-Glassport Bridge as

- 10 (a) Findings.--The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of
- 11 Pennsylvania finds and declares as follows:
- 12 Senator Edward P. Zemprelli will be honored for his 25
- 13 years of devoted public service to the residents of
- 14 Allegheny County. Among his many achievements, Senator
- 15 Zemprelli served five years as a State Representative
- prior to serving 20 years as a State Senator where he
- 17 served as both Majority Leader and Minority Leader.
- 18 (b) Redesignation. -- The bridge known as the Clairton-

- 1 Glassport Bridge, Department of Transportation No. 02-2038-0010-
- 2 0140, connecting the City of Clairton and the Borough of
- 3 Glassport, Allegheny County, is hereby redesignated as the
- 4 Senator Edward P. Zemprelli Bridge.
- 5 (c) Signs.--The Department of Transportation shall erect and
- 6 maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the bridge
- 7 redesignated in subsection (b) to traffic in both directions on
- 8 the bridge.
- 9 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
