AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 66 (Public Utilities) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, further providing for the prohibition
- 3 against standby charges.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 1326 of Title 66 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 8 § 1326. Standby charge prohibited.
- 9 (a) Prohibition.--A public utility that furnishes water to
- 10 or for the public shall not impose a standby charge on owners of
- 11 residential, commercial or industrial structures equipped with
- 12 automatic fire protection systems.
- 13 (b) Definition.--As used in this section, the term "standby
- 14 charge" means an amount however styled, in addition to the
- 15 regular rate, assessed against the owner of a residential,
- 16 <u>commercial or industrial</u> structure for the reason that the
- 17 residential, commercial or industrial structure is equipped with
- 18 an automatic fire protection system.

1 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
